A note from the pastor

This coming week, we celebrate the feast of St. Ignatius Loyola, the founder of the Jesuits. In the 16th century, he developed a means to find God's will that may be of interest to you. (In the Lord's Prayer, we pray, "thy will be done," but do we know what God's will is?) He called this prayer the Examen. I was introduced to it years ago and it is used by many as part of their evening prayer. It isn't complicated at all. It consists of 5 steps and takes about 20 minutes. Find yourself a quiet space away from the usual distractions you find in the evening such as television.

First, become aware of God's presence around you, recognizing that the Lord is always with you. Second, review the last 24 hours of your life with gratitude. Remember that every breath you take is a gift from God. Third, pay attention to your emotions. God speaks to us through our feelings. Fourth, choose one feature of the day and pray from it. This may be the place in which God wishes to speak with you. Fifth, look forward toward tomorrow. Again with gratitude and if need be, with sorrow where you have failed to live out your baptismal promises (that is, sinned).

So many people pray ever so briefly and hurriedly, saying the Lord's Prayer but never slowing down enough to listen to God. Try this simple process daily for a week. You might be in for a surprise. Through faith and obedience to the will of God, we are welcomed into a new relationship with the very God whom Jesus called "Abba."
