A note from the pastor

Next Saturday will be a memorable day for many of us as we gather at St. James Cathedral at 10 AM for the ordination of Larry Jesmer to the permanent diaconate. It has been a long and fruitful journey for Larry and Jeanine, prayerful and soul searching, challenging and gratifying. This is open to anyone who wishes to come. Since four other men are being ordained, I suggest you carpool and plan to come early if you want a good seat.

We have yet to learn if he will be assigned here but until we hear otherwise, that is our assumption. As is the case with any deacon, Larry's primary ministry will not be to assist me in the celebration of the Mass. In addition to preaching one weekend per month, Larry will continue in his ministry of preparing parents for the baptism of their infants and overseeing home visits to the sick. As a deacon, he can officiate at weddings and funerals. In addition, he is expected to be involved in a ministry of charity, so we are exploring how he can work with Good Cheer. We and the Church of Western Washington are blessed to have him in our midst as one who serves.

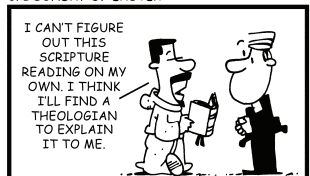
