Thank you for joining me today for worship. You are one reason why I chose to become a priest; to share the Eucharistic feast with you. How blessed we are to have this opportunity to dine at the Lord's table and to encounter him in the breaking of bread, which to me epitomizes the love Jesus has for us. We gather as a family, so I encourage you to take advantage of the time before and after Mass to personally welcome anyone you do not know.

Jesus left us with a command to love one another. How can we claim to love him if we don't welcome the stranger in our midst? The ideal time to do that is during the "gathering rite." That is the time before Mass begins as we gather to celebrate Mass, that time not when we sit in silence within the church preparing to celebrate Mass, but that time we have as we walk down the narthex toward the church. As summer nears, we will be blessed with many visitors, so please join me in welcoming them, especially if you encounter them on your way into the church itself.
