### A message from our pastor

Last weekend I announced the news that we paid off our debt for the building project, so we no longer have to make monthly payments. We did so by "borrowing" \$59,000 from our savings account in order to save the parish money on the interest. For this reason, you will still find envelopes for the building fund in the pews. Any donations you make to the building fund will go into savings to replenish what was taken out last month to pay off the debt. If you made a pledge that is not yet paid in full, I hope that you will still honor your pledge as the money is still needed. Hopefully we will not need to borrow from our savings in the coming fiscal year for parish operations but that depends on your stewardship. We were fortunate to have had some generous unexpected gifts this year that provided a cushion when needed. If you have not made a gift to the building fund in the past, please consider doing so now. Every gift of any amount matters. Thank you for making our new facility a reality.
