A message from our pastor

As Catholics, we are blessed with seven sacraments. Some can only be received once: baptism, confirmation, and Holy Orders. The others can be received more than once: matrimony, anointing of the sick, eucharist, and reconciliation. Statistically, the one that Catholics shy away from the most is reconciliation, also known as penance or confession. Perhaps you are one of them. And why is that? Could it be bad memories from childhood? Or the sense that you don't need the sacrament? Let us not kid ourselves. We all need it. Even the Pope does. This sacrament is as vital to our spiritual well being as the Eucharist, and perhaps even more so, since we cannot receive the graces of Eucharist if we have committed a grave sin purposefully. I invite you to prayerfully reflect on what keeps you away from allowing a priest to say to you, "Go in peace, your sins are forgiven." Is it a notion of shame? Embarrassment? Fear that you would be thought less of? Be assured that whatever you say remains a secret between you, the priest, and God. In the past, penance may have seem like a punishment, but I (and I suspect many of my brother priests do the same) view penance as a prescription to recovering a wholeness that is lost when we sin. God endeavors to restore our innocence. God sees so much more in you than the sins you committed and rejoices at the opportunity to embrace you with love, just as the prodigal son was embraced. There is more to this sacrament than forgiveness; it is also one of healing and transformation, drawing us closer to God. For this reason, the Church encourages use this sacrament to confess all our sins. If Saturday afternoons is not a good time, do not hesitate to call me for an appointment. Many other parishioners do. I would gladly consider scheduling a regular time elsewhere during the week if there is sufficient interest. Be assured that you have nothing to lose and much to gain when you make time to celebrate this sacrament!

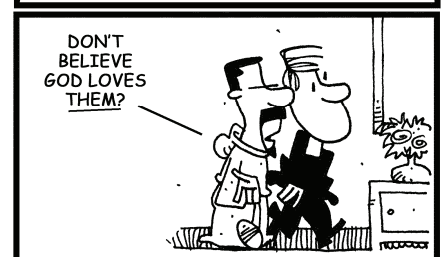
