WHO SAYS?

From every corner of our parish questions arise about policies and procedures. Where do they come from and since when have they been in practice? In my bookcase is a 250 pg. *Parish Personnel Policy and Procedure Manual* from the Archdiocese of Seattle which is updated regularly for those who administrate parishes and other archdiocesan agencies. On my desk is the 1993 edition of St. Hubert's Policy and Procedure Manual which is, in itself, 50 pages long. Fr. Spicer and the office staff are currently updating this manual to correlate it with the one from the chancery and reexamine some of the policies to see if they still meet our needs (they go back five pastors.) You can be certain of one thing; we haven't made them up as we went along.

There have been misunderstandings about regulations, budgets, accountability etc. but the archdiocese is quite clear about finance, insurance, liability, occupancy, and responsibility and they carefully spell out job descriptions for those who administer them. The Corporation of the Catholic Archdiocese of Seattle operates like any large corporation with security measures, audits, overseers (we submitted accountings of the building project once a month even though they had an agent here) and our accountability is very precise. We will be spending this summer and fall asking for mission statements and goals, your procedures (we started with the Liturgy Committee,) and even a brief history. These are going into our updated 2008 (well, maybe 2009) Procedure Manual and hopefully things will be more clear.
