A note from your pastor

We have included in the bulletin this week a summary of our parish finances for the past fiscal year, which ended on June 30, 2008. Notice there are two columns of figures: the left features what we actually collected and spent; resulting in a net income of \$34,616. The column on the right is what we predicted more than a year ago when we sat down to write last year's budget. No one has a crystal ball to fully foretell the future, but all things considered, the finance council did a good job with its estimates. Our year was successful, thanks first of all to the generous support of our parishioners but also because everyone involved was prudent with their expenses. Overall, I felt we exercised good stewardship.

This year we anticipate our expenses to be \$410,000, which as you can see is big increase over last year. In putting our administrative budget together, we use directives from the archdiocese, thus there is an increase of \$60,400 for salaries, medical benefits, the annual assessment, and insurance. Also, we are spending more money on adult education and faith formation. Overall, I feel that we have a frugal budget, yet one that allows for enriching the programs that are vital for faith formation for all ages.

Last year, we withdrew \$157,475 from our savings to pay our debt. I hope that we don't have to do that this year. Please contribute to our building fund by using the designated envelopes so that we can keep our savings for a "rainy" day, when something unexpected might happen. In closing, I want to thank you for your generous support of the parish. Also, I am looking for new members to serve on the finance council. If you feel that you have a good insight to offer in this regards, please contact me.
